



## **FOREWORD**

Education Management Information System (EMIS) cell of Elementary & Secondary Education Department, Government of NWFP is maintaining and updating education database yearly in order to fulfill the information requirements of policy formulation, decision-making, interventions and resource allocation and of other national and international organizations. The EMIS Cell is responsible for conducting census of all Govt. schools including Primary, Middle, High and Higher Secondary Schools, Private Schools in the Province. It generates and publishes Provincial Statistical Report every year. Till date, EMIS has generated and published 17 Provincial Annual School Census (ASC) Statistical Reports but this is the first time that EMIS has generated and is publishing comprehensive District Statistical Report containing analysis. This report of EMIS will help the decision-makers to use data for planning, management, monitoring and evaluation of the education system at various administrative levels especially at individual district levels. It provides important data to share with state and national decision makers to increase public awareness and advance public policy and support for education. The data will provide base to develop vital education indicators, which will help the decision makers for necessary interventions in the education system.

The report covers the following aspects of Government Schools in the Province:

- Number of Schools, Enrollment and Teachers by gender and level
- Gross and Net Enrollment Ratios by gender and level
- Dropout, Transition and Retention Rates
- Students Flow Analysis
- Major/Minor repair required in the Government Schools

EMIS analyzes data and generates reports according to the need of data users. In addition, demand based reports can be produced. All data users are encouraged & welcome to contact Provincial EMIS for any query or detailed information. Suggestions for further improvement of this publication will contribute a lot to strengthen EMIS in future, which results in the development of education sector based on quality segregated and updated database and multidimensional reports.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- There are 984 functional Govt. Primary Schools in Haripur, out of which 663 are Boys Schools and 321 are Girls Schools. While at Secondary (Middle, High and H/Secondary) level total functional Schools are 228 including 142 male and 86 female Schools.
- Total Enrolment at Primary level is 93, 914 out of which 49, 828 are Boys and 44,086 are Girls students. While at secondary level the overall enrolment is 52, 109 out of which 29,822 are male and 22,287 are female students.
- The average Students in Government Primary School are 95 students while at secondary level the figure is 229.
- The number of total Working Teachers in Govt. Primary Schools is 3,031 out of which Male teachers are 1,760 and Female teachers are 1,271. At secondary level overall number of teachers is 2,376 out of which 1,550 are male and 826 are female teachers.
- The Average Teacher: Student Ratio in Government Primary Schools level is 1:31 and Secondary Schools level is 1:22.
- The Gross Enrolment Ratio in Govt. Primary schools of Haripur is 74%.
- The Gross Enrolment Ratio in Non-Govt. Primary schools of Haripur is 27% (projected).
- The Overall Gross Enrolment Ratio (Govt. Schools, Non-Govt. Schools & Deeni Madaris) of District Haripur is 102%.
- The Gross Enrolment Ratio in Govt. Secondary schools of Haripur is 42%.
- The Gross Enrolment Ratio in Non-Govt. Secondary Schools of Haripur is 12% (projected).
- The Overall Gross Enrolment Ratio (Govt. and Non-Govt. Secondary Level Schools) of District Haripur is 54%, depicting that about 46% children of Secondary level school going age are either out of school/in Deeni Madaris/unknown.

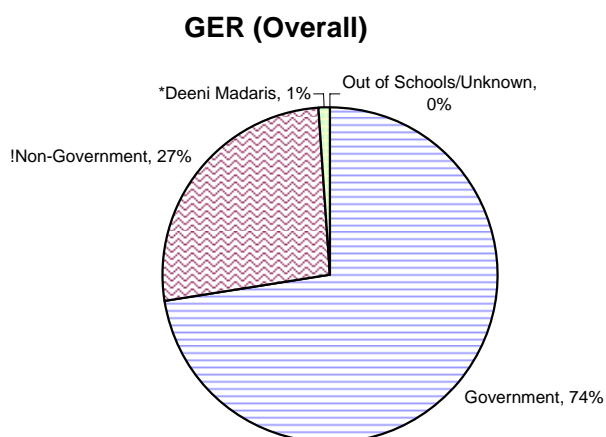

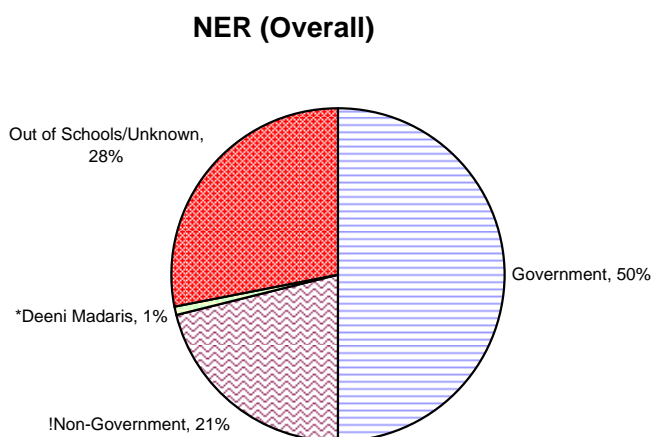

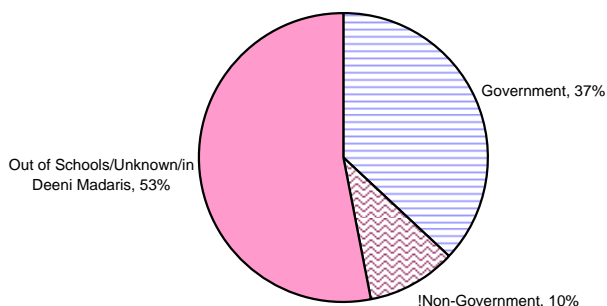

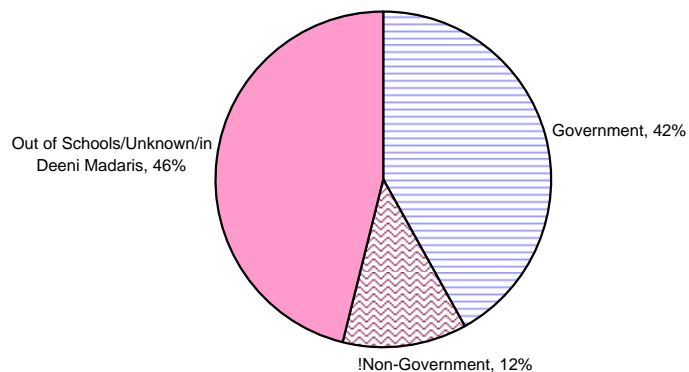

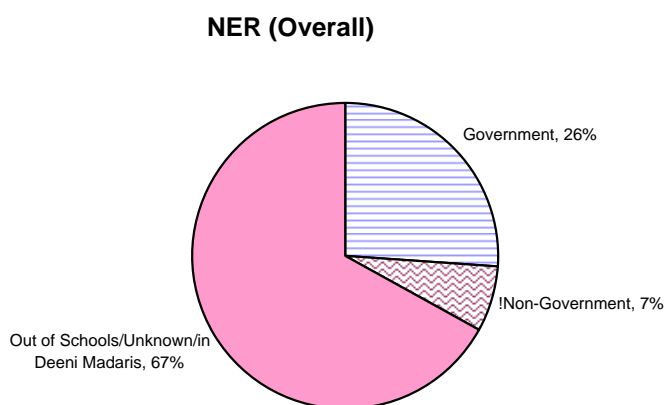

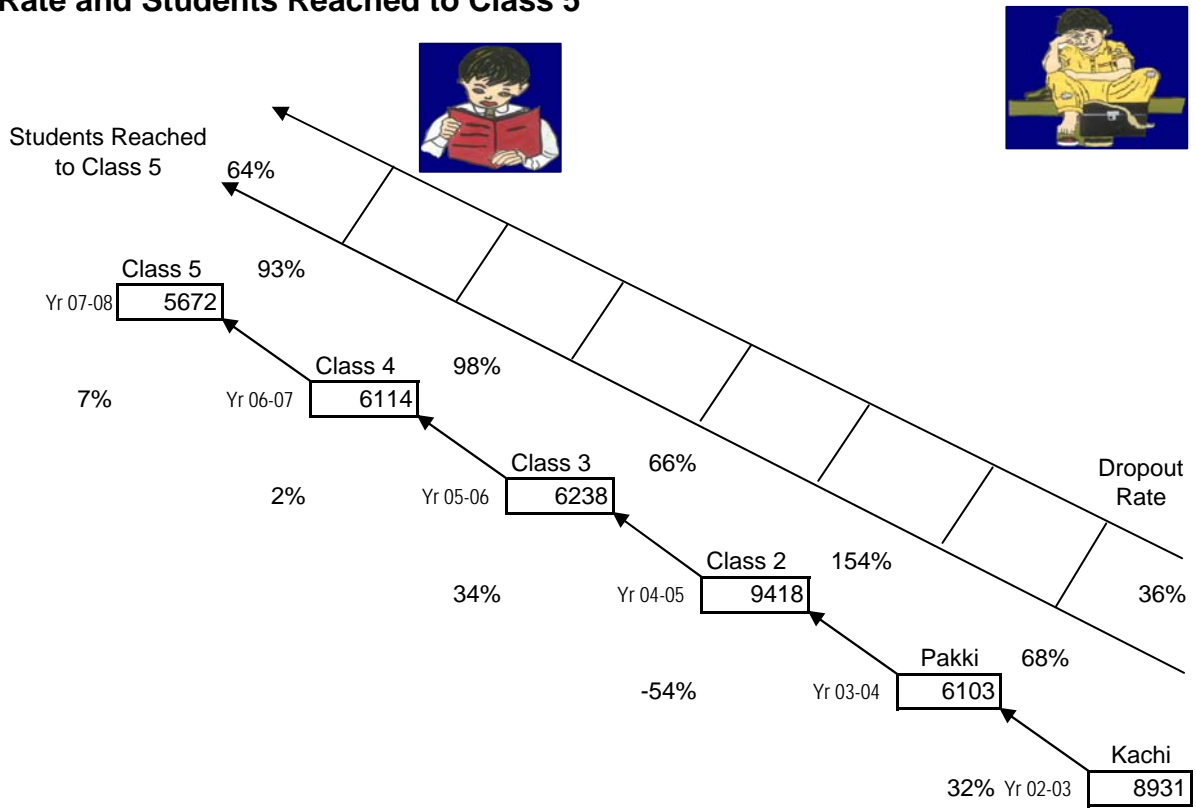
**Dropout Rate and Students Reached to Class 5**

**Dropout Rate and Students Reached to Class 5**

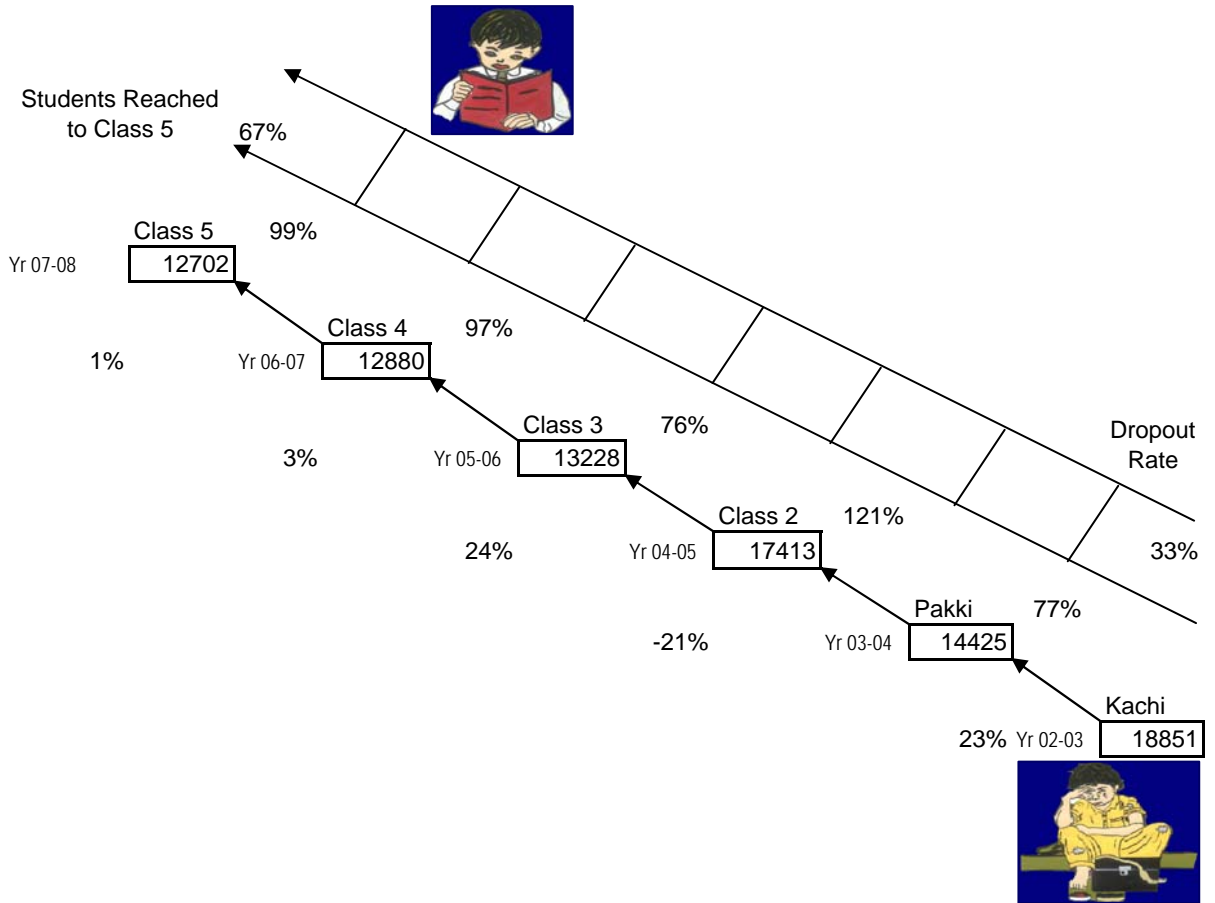

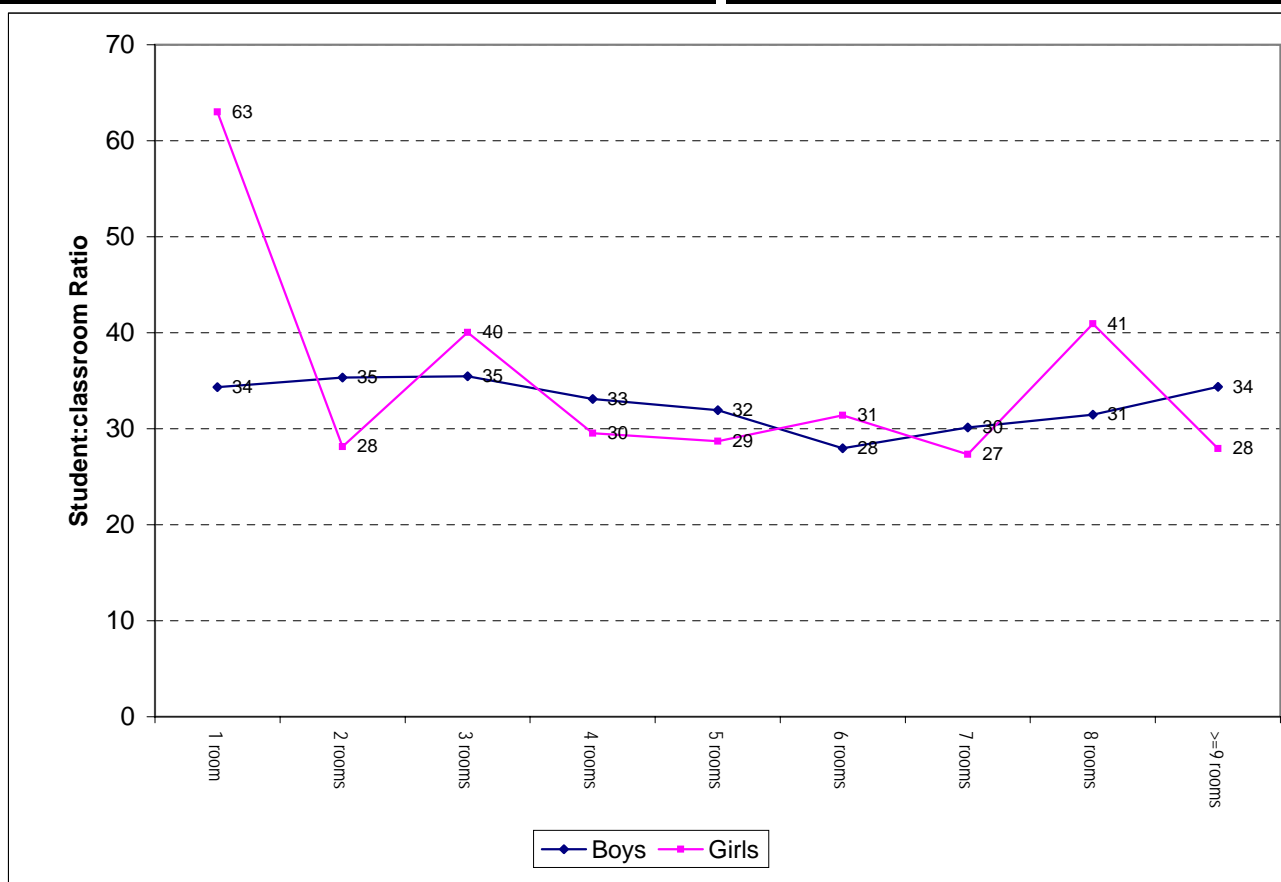
